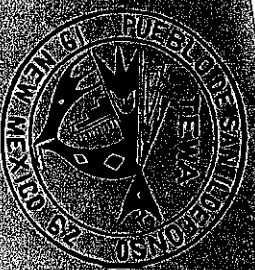

Afterschool Program

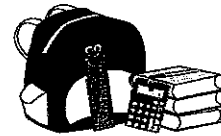

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

It's a privilege to teach the art of traditional Indian sewing to students who wish to continue keeping up with the time-honored apparel worn in our present day, traditional dances. Class will be instructed to provide cultural context to objects, processes, and the sewing projects themselves. The students will learn, step-by-step, the flow of sewing techniques, the mathematics of measurement, and how to:

- Design their own pattern(s) of a traditional pueblo style garment;
- Identify and match fabric to the different colors style of project in its uniqueness. The project will depend on the desired size and require the color, fabric types, thread, trim accessories, and overall cost;
- Select the right material for future sewing project(s);
- Learn how to design, cut, and pin fabric for a proper fit; and learn to sew and finish the garment.

NOTE: Please bring your own sewing machine. (Instructor will provide 1 sewing machine, ONLY)

This class is designed to expand the knowledge of sewing traditional garments and to pass that knowledge down to the student's children. It is so important in carrying on the traditional customs of our Pueblo people and to wear clothing we sewed for ceremonies that we partake in. The finished projects are reflections of our Pueblo heritage that can be passed onto future generations, and the course is based on student interest.
